#### Dear COLLS Families,

We have had a busy spring with interest in COLLS. We have had student visitors in multiple grades, students shadow, and families begin the registration process. Just so you are aware of the process,



once a student in grades 1-8 begins the registration process, we encourage a shadow day where the student can get to know us and we can get to know the student. I conduct a student interview with each 1st-8th grader, and we work with the family to make sure that it is the right fit for all involved. We also give an assessment to see where the child is academically. We use all these tools to gauge if we can serve a child's needs, if the family is open to working with us, and if the child will benefit from being a Crown of Life student. No enrollment is taken lightly. As more and more families look to COLLS for their school family, we will continue this process and adjust to be as proactive as possible to help new students and new families engage at COLLS and maintain the integrity of our current community.

As we close out this week, we celebrate and support what is happening at Crown of Life with our Kentucky Derby Gala. I am looking forward to the fun and fellowship tonight. Our community has already been so supportive. We will use the proceeds to help renovate the science lab, purchase additional science materials for hands-on learning, expand STEM/STEAM opportunities, and look toward updating mulch and fencing at the playground. I want to extend a huge thank you to Peyton Satterwhite for her coordination, creativity, time, and energy given to planning and running the gala.
